Living as Co-Heirs with YAHUSHUA(JESUS)

Hello All! Today I am going to go into, Living as Co Heirs with YAHUSHUA(JESUS). Living as co-heirs with YAHUSHUA is a truth we find in the New Testament, by the Apostle Paul. This emphasizes the believer's union with YAHUSHUA and the shared inheritance that comes through Faith in HIM. We have eternal hope that is granted to us, who are in YAHUSHUA(JESUS).

Looking in Romans 8:17 it says **"And if we are children, then we are heirs: heirs of GOD and co-heirs with YAHUSHUA-** if indeed we suffer with HIM, so that we may also be glorified with HIM." This talks about how we have a one-on-one intimate relationship with YAHUSHUA, we are adopted into YAHUVEH GODS family.

As Christians we share in the inheritance promised to the SON.

When we understand that we are **Adopted**, we can understand our status as **Co-heirs**.

In **Galatians 4:4-7** it says, "But when the fullness of time had come, YAH sent forth HIS SON , born of woman, born under the law." Paul talks about that YAHUVEH GOD sent HIS SON YAHUSHUA to redeem those under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons(and daughters).

Being Adopted is not merely a legal status but a transformation, granting us as believers the rights and privileges of being YAH'S children.

Ephesians 1:11-14 speaks of believers having obtained an inheritance

Which is sealed by the HOLY SPIRIT, as a guarantee of what is to come.

What does this Inheritance include?

-Eternal life

-The kingdom of YAHUVEH GOD

-The Fullness of Salvation

It is a Promise of Sharing in YAHUSHUAS (JESUS) glory and Reign, which it talks about in 2 Timothy 2:12 "If we endure, we will also reign with HIM."

In **Romans 8:17**, it mentions the suffering alongside YAHUSHUA as a condition for sharing in HIS Glory. This suffering is not punitive but participatory, which reflects believers' identification with YAHUSHUAS own sufferings.

We see in **Philippians 3:10-11** it says something similar " I want to know YAHUSHUA and the power of HIS resurrection and the fellowship of HIS sufferings, being conformed to HIM in HIS death, and so somehow, to attain to the resurrection from the dead".

- We have to keep in mind that we will go through trials, we will go through tests, and hardships for the sake of YAHUSHUA(JESUS). It will, not always be easy but everything we face and go through on this earth is worth it , YAHUSHUA paid the highest price for us so we could be set free, healed, and delivered and have eternal life. So we praise YAHUVEH GOD we thank YAHUSHUA for everything HE allows is for our good. We have the best helper, and we are never alone. Remember, HE is our Hope. We can take comfort in this

Living as Co-heirs with YAHUSHUA calls for a life, that reflects the values and character of the kingdom of YAHUVEH GOD.

-It involves a commitment to:

-Holiness

-love

-Service (Which we can see in Colossians 3:23-24 "Whatever you do, work at it with your whole being, for the LORD and not for men, because you know that you will receive an inheritance from the LORD as your reward. It is the LORD YAHUSHUA you are serving".

- This Perspective transforms our daily life's, this gives us purpose and hope as YAHUVEH GOD , YAHUSHUA has a purpose for us a plan for each of HIS children and our blessed hope is in HIM.*

Being Co-Heirs with YAHUSHUA (JESUS)., emphasizes the unity of believers with HIM and with one another:

Ephesians 3:6 reveals that gentiles are "Fellow heirs' fellow members of the body, and fellow and fellow partakers of the promise in YAHUSHUA through the gospel.

Being Co-heirs, with YAHUSHUA (JESUS), speaks to us (believers) about our:

1. Identity

2. Inheritance

3. Our calling

4. It offers a vision of life that is deeply rooted in the promises and purposes of YAHUVEH GOD.

Through our Faith in YAHUSHUA(JESUS) we are invited to participate in the fullness of our inheritance

What does it mean to be Adopted?

It means, We have a new Identity through YAHUSHUA(JESUS) and status in YAH'S family. In **Galatians 4:4-7** it explains this showing that through YAHUSHUA, believers are no longer slaves but sons and heirs. This adoption is acceptance into YAHUVEH GOD'S family.

In **John 1:12-13** it talks about that those who receive YAHUSHUA (JESUS) are given the right to become children of YAHUVEH GOD. This talks about the necessity of Faith in YAHUSHUA for salvation and adoption, which emphasizes that it is through HIS sacrifice and resurrection that we can be reconciled to YAHUVEH GOD.

In **Ephesians 1:9-11** it elaborates on YAH'S will, revealing the mystery of HIS purpose in YAHUSHUA. This talks about the grace and love inherent in YAH'S decision to adopt believers.

Teaching Points:

- 1. Understanding predestination is a divine act of YAHUVEH GOD, which is rooted in YAH'S sovereignty and grace. It is assuring, to believers of our secure place in YAHUVEH GOD'S family.**
- 2. YAHUVEH's actions are motivated by HIS good pleasure, reflecting HIS love and purpose for humanity. As believers, we can trust HIS perfect will for our lives.**
- 3. As adopted children of YAH'S, we are called to live out our identity in YAHUSHUA reflecting HIS character and love in our daily lives.**

Adoption provides assurance of YAHUVEH GOD'S unchanging love and security of being part of HIS eternal family, praise YAH for this.

Bible Study Questions:

1. How does being called a "child of GOD" change the way you see your self-worth and value?
- 2, Why do you think Paul connects our future glory with sharing in YAHUSHUAS sufferings in Romans 8:17?
3. How can hard times and trials in your life actually prepare your heart to appreciate GODs gifts more?
4. What is one specific worry or burden you are carrying that you can surrender today, knowing your future is secure in your eternal inheritance?
- 5.What does it mean that we are Co-heirs with YAHUSHUA(JESUS)?
- 6.Living as co-heirs involves?
7. What does it look like to live in true, unified community with other believers when we all share the exact same spiritual inheritance?
- 8.How does realizing you are an heir to GODs grace help you extend forgiveness to someone who has wronged you?
