

THE ANTICHRIST & THE ANTICHRIST SPIRIT WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE?

Today, I am going to briefly cover over about the Antichrist, that is to come, and those who have the antichrist spirit. What is the difference?

You can also read over the book of John, The Book of Revelations, & 2 Thessalonians to learn more. I have provided some verses on it below.

There is many people who have the SPIRIT of the antichrist in them, this **Doesnt** mean that they are the Antichrist.

For example, Hitler as we all know is very Evil, people thought he was the antichrist, he wasnt but he does have the Antichrist Spirit in him. I will share more about what that means. Re: the Antichrist that is to appear/come, who is the son of satan, He will be worse than Hitler.)
What does the Antichrist spirit mean?

The phrase **spirit of the antichrist** is found in 1 John 4:2-3:

“This is how you can recognize the Spirit of God: Every spirit that acknowledges that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God, but every spirit that does not acknowledge Jesus is not from God. This is the spirit of the antichrist, which you have heard is coming and even now is already in the world.”

But how do we test the spirits? How can we discern which teachers are imparting truth? How do we recognize the spirit of the antichrist?

YAHUVEH GOD says in HIS Word, we are to test the SPIRIT that speaks, by examining there Fruits. Do they have the Fruits of the SPIRIT? are they teaching about Salvation through JESUS (YAHUSHUA in hebrew)? Are they teaching about Obedience? Holiness? that there is only one way to the Father which is JESUS? HE is the only one who can intercede on our behalf, before GOD. You cannot pray to saints,).

Is what there teaching lining up with the Bible? Can you hear/discern GODS voice through them and what they share? You have to be able to have **discernment** which is something we all need to pray for each day.

Remember those who are of the devil, who have the antichrist spirit in them, can mix truth with lies. That is why you have to be careful who your listening too, or going by and be discerning.

What does the Bible say about the Antichrist?

First John 2:18 speaks of the Antichrist: “Dear children, this is the last hour; and as you have heard that the antichrist is coming, even now many antichrists have come. This is how we know it is the last hour.”

The specific term *antichrist* is used five times in Scripture, twice here in 1 John 2:18 and once in 1 John 2:22; 4:3; and 2 John 1:7. So, what is this Antichrist that the apostle John refers to?

The meaning of the term *antichrist* is simply “against Christ.” As the apostle John records in First and Second John, an antichrist denies the Father and the Son (1 John 2:22), does not acknowledge Jesus (1 John 4:3), and denies that Jesus came in the flesh (2 John 1:7). There have been many “antichrists,” as 1 John 2:18 states. But there is also coming *the* Antichrist.

In the end times/last hour, a man will arise to oppose JESUS (YAHUSHUA in hebrew) and His followers more than anyone else in history. claiming to be the true Messiah, the **Antichrist will seek world domination and will attempt to destroy all followers of Jesus Christ and the nation of Israel.**

The Bible teaches that the world will eventually produce a world ruler, called **“the beast”** in Revelation, who will wield great power and demand worship of himself. He will have **“a mouth to utter proud words and blasphemies”** (Revelation 13:5) and is empowered by Satan (Revelation 13:2). He is called **“the man of lawlessness . . . the man doomed to destruction”** in 2 Thessalonians 2:3.

The Antichrist of the end times will embody all the deception and perversion of truth that the spirit of the antichrist has always promoted.

Today, **“the secret power of lawlessness is already at work”** (2 Thessalonians 2:7). The same spirit that will empower the Antichrist of the last days is currently operating in the world to bring confusion and deception to the issue of Jesus Christ’s person and work. **“This is the spirit of the antichrist, which you have heard is coming and even now is already in the world”** (1 John 4:3).

Other biblical references to the Antichrist include the following:

The imposing, boastful king of Daniel 7 who oppresses the Jews and tries to “change the set times and the laws” (verse 25)

.

The leader who establishes a 7-year covenant with Israel and then breaks it in Daniel 9.

The king who sets up the abomination of desolation in Mark 13:14 (cf. Daniel 9:27).

The man of lawlessness in 2 Thessalonians 2:1–12

The rider on a white horse (representing his claim to be a man of peace) in Revelation 6:2.

The first beast--the one from the sea—in Revelation 13. This beast receives power from the dragon (Satan) and speaks “proud words and blasphemies” (verse 5) and wages war against the saints (verse 7).

Thankfully, the Antichrist/beast, along with his false prophet, will be thrown into the lake of fire, where they will spend all eternity in torment (Revelation 19:20; 20:10).

What is the Antichrist? In summary, the Antichrist is the end-times false messiah who seeks, and likely achieves, world domination so that he can destroy Israel and all followers of Jesus Christ.

Verses on The Antichrist:

2 John 1:7

For many deceivers have gone out into the world, those who do not confess the coming of Jesus Christ in the flesh. Such a one is the deceiver and the antichrist.

1 John 2:22

Who is the liar but he who denies that Jesus is the Christ? This is the antichrist, he who denies the Father and the SON".

1 John 2:18

Children, it is the last hour, and as you have heard that antichrist is coming, so now many antichrists have come. Therefore we know that it is the last hour.

Matthew 24:24

For false christs and false prophets will arise and perform great signs and wonders, so as to lead astray, if possible, even the elect

Who is The Beast?

.Revelation 13:5-8 declares,

“The beast was given a mouth to utter proud words and blasphemies and to exercise his authority for forty-two months. He opened his mouth to blaspheme God, and to slander his name and his dwelling place and those who live in heaven. He was given power to make war against the saints and to conquer them. And he was given authority over every tribe, people, language and nation. All inhabitants of the earth will worship the beast—all whose names have not been written in the book of life belonging to the Lamb that was slain from the creation of the world.

The beast will receive a deadly wound and be healed of it (Revelation 13:3). He will exert authority over the whole world and demand worship (verses 7–8). He will wage war against God’s people, and he will prevail against them for a time (Revelation 13:7; Daniel 7:21). However, the beast’s time is short: according to Revelation 13:5 and Daniel 7:25, he will only be permitted absolute authority for forty-two months (three-and-a-half years).

We believe that the beast in Revelation is the **Antichrist**, the one who will “oppose and will exalt himself over everything that is called God or is worshiped, so that he sets himself up in God’s temple, proclaiming himself to be God” (2 Thessalonians 2:4). He is also called “**the man of lawlessness**” and “**the man doomed to destruction**” (2 Thessalonians 2:3). In Daniel’s vision, the

Antichrist is the “little horn” that rises from the head of the terrifying beast (Daniel 7:8).

When the Lord returns in judgment, He will defeat the beast and destroy his empire (Revelation 19:19–20; cf. Daniel 7:11). The beast will be cast alive into the lake of fire

The identity of the individual who will become the beast of Revelation is not yet known. According to 2 Thessalonians 2:7, The man of lawlessness cannot be unveiled while what is restraining him now is at work. Paul refers also to he who now restrains. Scholarly theories on the identity of this restrainer include the Roman Empire/emperor, The HOLY SPIRIT, and the Archangel Michael. The restrainer makes sure that the man of lawlessness is revealed in his time, and not before (see verse 3).

How is Sunday Worship in connection with the Mark of the Beast?

Anyone who accepts the Sunday law, that is going to be enforced, will be giving their allegiance and worship to the beast (Roman Catholic Church) instead of God. Then they will be marked (spiritually) with the mark of the beast, either in their forehead, or in their hand.

Those that are written in the Lambs book of Life, will know **NOT** to take the

Mark of the Beast, as GOD will not loose one soul who is written in the Lambs Book of Life.
