Ephesians 2:8
8 "For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of GOD
"

Ephesians 1:7
"In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of GOD's grace"

Titus 3:7
7 so that, having been justified by his grace, we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life.

We see with the following above verses on Grace, that Grace has to do with it being:

1. A Gift from YAHUVEH GOD.
2. HIS grace is similar to HIS Mercy towards us, that we are forgiven
3. Hope of eternal life
4. Through grace were saved by our Faith

Breaking this down and summing it up , Grace is :

YAHUVEH GODS Favor and Love for us

Praise YAH that HE has shown us so much love, mercy, & grace. Even though we do not deserve this, HE loves us that much and wants us to be reconciled to HIM through HIS SON YAHUSHUA (JESUS).

YAHUVEH GOD's Word says in : Jeremiah 29:13 ESV "You will seek me and find me, when you seek me with all your heart."

HE waits for you with open Arms- HIS Grace, is amazing just like HIS Love is too. And HE is merciful to forgive you of all of your sin(s) because HE sent HIS SON YAHUSHUA (JESUS) to this earth to go through the suffering WE deserve for our sins. HE paid the High price for us. 2. Another part, aspect of HIS Grace is, knowing that we are NEVER alone on this earth. We know that HE is there holding out hand every step of the way, each day. This is a comfort, knowing that we can always go to HIM about everything, we can always seek HIM and take heart knowing that We are never alone, remember feelings are of the flesh. Once again the devil is the only one who will tell you you are alone" this is a Lie.

HIS Word says, "

1. Deuteronomy 31:6 – "Be strong and of a good courage, fear not, nor be afraid of them: for the Lord thy GOD he it is that doth go with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee."
.Isn't that a wonderful comfort? there are a lot of verses that talk about How YAHUVEH GOD is always there with us, and that we are Never alone.
