Episode # 3 Ruth & her Faithfulness

For today's Bible Study, From Episode # 3 Ruth and Her Faithfulness Salt n Light Reflections, read the below material and answer the questions, also there is Assignments, feel free to listen to the Episode as well if you would like)

Ruth was a Moabite woman who showed loyalty to her Israelite mother-in-law, Naomi, and later married Boaz, becoming the great-grandmother of King David.

Some things we can learn and take away from the Book of Ruth is, despite difficult circumstances, we as believers can be encouraged to trust in YAH'S provision rather than seeking solutions that are outside of YAHUVEH GODS will.

Ruth's faithfulness reminds us that we can remain steadfast, in our commitments even when life has challenging moments.

After Ruth lost her husband, she could have returned to the comfort of where she was from in Moab, but instead Ruth chose to remain with Naomi saying "Your people shall be my people, and your GOD, my GOD" Ruth 1:16. ESV). This was a bold move to make because there was no promise of security and she would need to trust in YAHUVEH GOD to provide for her.

In Bethlehem her hard work and her humility allowed her to find favor. She gleaned in the fields to provide for Naomi, which she would later find out that Boaz, the landowner would be her redeemer. Ruth ended up marrying Boaz later on and had obed and became the great grandmother of king David. In ruth we can be reminded that YAHUVEH GOD does not forget the faithful, HE sees all of those who are humble, and those who honor loyalty, = When we study the book of ruth, we can see how important it is to walk by faith even when things don't seem clear to us.

We can also learn from Ruth how hard work and being humble can help us, and how important it is to remain humble. Ruth had courage, to face the unknown, and even faced poverty yet she trusted in YAHUVEH GOD, and because of her faithfulness she was blessed and taken care of. I think we can understand from this book, the importance of staying humble, obedient, being a hard worker, I staying loyal and having faith.

Ruth was living during a time in judges, which was a period marked by chaos and disobedience in Israel. But even though many people turned away from YAHUVEH GOD, Ruth turned toward HIM.

Ruth reminds us that YAHUVEH GOD works through our faithfulness, Ruth was a widow from a foreign land , who chose loyalty over comforts and faith instead of fear because of her Trust in YAHUVEH GOD, she became part of a bigger story, one that led to the coming of YAHUSHUA (JESUS).
