In **Chapter 1, verse 17**, it talks about YAHUVEH GOD's righteousness, but what does it mean?

The righteousness of GOD most likely means "Righteousness from GOD" it reflects a right standing before GOD that is given to people by GOD (**see Phil 3:9**).

The phrase likely has meaning in (**Romans 3:21-22 and 2 Corinthians 5:21**) as well (**see notes on those verses**) however, the expression probably also refers to YAHUVEH GODS righteous moral character, this is seen in HIS holiness and justice.

It is also seen in the way that HIS act of saving sinners through YAHUSHUAs sacrifice meets the just demand of HIS holy nature, from faith for faith probably means that right standing with GOD is by faith from start to finish shall live by Faith. People receive the gift of salvation by faith, it is also by faith that they live each day. See (**Hab 2:4**.)

**\* Notes on verses Romans 3:21-22 & 2 Corinthians 5:21):**

- **Romans chapter 3:21-22:** The saving Righteousness of YAH. Paul now, explains that people can have a right standing before YAHUVEH GOD, only through Faith in the atoning work of YAHUSHUA on the cross.
- **2 Corinthians 5:21 :** This verse is one of the most important in all of Scripture for understanding the meaning of the atonement and

justification. The one who knew no sin is YAHUSHUA. (v.20). And HE (GOD) made HIM, (YAHUSHUA), to be sin. GOD the Father made YAHUSHUA to be viewed and treated as "sin" even though YAHUSHUA himself never sinned. (**Hebrews 4:15**), **see Galatians 3:13**)

- For our sake GOD viewed and treated "our" sin as if it belonged to YAHUSHUA himself. Thus YAHUSHUA "died for all" (**2 Corinthians 5:14**) and became our substitute. YAHUSHUA took the punishment that we deserved (1 peter 2:24).
- The background for this is **Isiash 53**- Prophecy of YAHUSHUAS death(crucifixion). It contains several parallels to **2 Corinthians 5:21**. So that in HIM we might become the Righteousness of GOD. Just as GOD gave our sin and guilt to YAHUSHUA ("HE made him to be sin") so GOD also gives YAHUSHUAS righteousness to all who believe in YAHUSHUA.(JESUS).

**Some Verses on GODS Righteousness:**

1 John 3:7 ESV Little children, let no one deceive you. Whoever practices righteousness is righteous, as he is righteous.

Romans 1:17 ESV For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith for faith, as it is written, "The righteous shall live by faith."

1 John 2:29 ESV If you know that he is righteous, you may be sure that everyone who practices righteousness has been born of him.

1 John 2:1 ESV My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father,

Jesus Christ the righteous.

Isaiah 53:11 ESV Out of the anguish of his soul he shall see and be satisfied; by his knowledge shall the righteous one, my servant, make many to be accounted righteous, and he shall bear their iniquities.

James 3:18 ESV And a harvest of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.

Ephesians 2:8-9 ESV For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

Galatians 2:16 ESV Yet we know that a person is not justified by works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ, so we also have believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified by faith in Christ and not by works of the law, because by works of the law no one will be justified.

Matthew 5:6 ESV "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.

Psalms 34:15 ESV The eyes of the Lord are toward the righteous and his ears toward their cry.

2 Timothy 3:16 ESV All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness,

2 Timothy 2:22 ESV So flee youthful passions and pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace, along with those who call on the Lord from a pure heart.
